

Re: Asbestos Hazardous Emergency Response Act (AHERA) Notification

As part of our commitment to ensuring the safety and well-being of our students, faculty, and staff, we are writing to inform you about our efforts to address potential asbestos hazards in our school building.

Our school, Harding Fine Arts Academy, is housed in a historic building that is over 100 years old. Given the age of the building, it is possible that asbestoscontaining materials may be present. Asbestos, if disturbed, can pose serious health risks, including respiratory issues and cancer. Therefore, it is essential for us to take proactive measures to address this potential hazard.

In compliance with the Asbestos Hazardous Emergency Response Act (AHERA), 15 U.S.C. 2641 and CFR 763, we have conducted an asbestos inspection and developed an Asbestos Management Plan (AMP) to manage any asbestos-containing materials found in our building. The AMP includes inspections, monitoring, and appropriate response actions to ensure the safety of everyone within our school community.

As part of our ongoing commitment to transparency and communication, we want to assure you that we are diligently working to maintain a safe and healthy environment for our students, faculty, and staff.
